



Fabric Flip-Fold

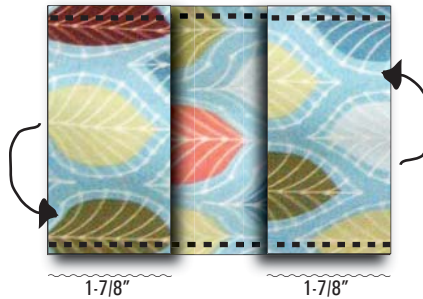
A fabric "card-fold" that holds your driver's license, credit cards, library card, business cards, etc. Stash folded bills behind cards.



Fits in pocket or purse. Made with fabric scraps reinforced with fusible interfacing and ribbon trim.

- WHAT YOU NEED:**
- Fabric scraps
 - Ribbon scraps
 - Fusible interfacing
 - Thread

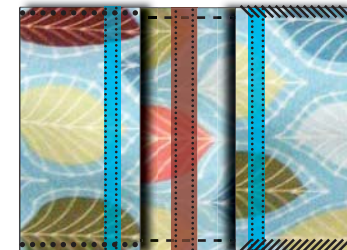
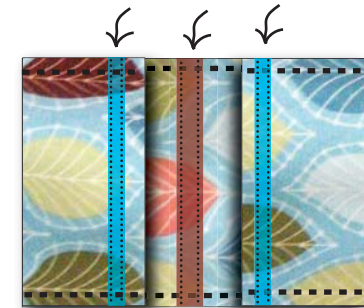
1. Cut two pieces of fabric (one for inside one for outside) each 4-1/2" by 9-1/2".
2. Cut two pieces of light-weight fusible interfacing each 4" x 9".
3. Center the interfacing on the wrong side of the fabric pieces and fuse following the manufacturer's directions.
4. Using an iron, press the 1/4" edges of the fabric toward the interfacing on all sides.
5. Pin the wrong sides together and stitch 1/8" around the entire perimeter.
6. With outside fabric on desktop, fold sides in 1-7/8" toward inside fabric and pin.



8. Stitch both side edges on each side as close to edge as possible. You can stitch through all thickness (shown on left-side) or stitch the side seam (shown on right-side).



7. Sew on ribbon or trim if desired.



9. Fold and stuff with cards, money, etc. Put in your pocket and go!
